Did you know that ...

Head lice and nits are very common in young children and their families. They do not have anything to do with dirty hair and are picked up by head-to-head contact.

Head lice are small insects. They can be difficult to spot in your hair. Head lice eggs (nits) are brown or white (empty shells) and attached to the hair.
