### *Internet Safety*

Last week was National Internet Safety Week. Mrs Lakin led a range of assemblies to remind pupils about keeping safe on line. These are some reminders:

#### Think then Click

We expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet, just as they are anywhere else in school. This includes materials they choose to access and language they choose to use.

- We ask permission before using the Internet
- We only use websites approved by an adult
- We tell an adult if we see anything we are uncomfortable with
- We immediately turn off the screen if we not sure about a website
- We send e-mails that are polite and friendly
- We never give out personal information or passwords
- We never arrange to meet anyone we don't know
- We do not open e-mails sent by anyone we don't know
- We do not use Internet chat rooms
- We do not download anything without permission
- We ask before printing anything out

## **School website**

Mrs Lakin has been working with pupils across the school to develop a range of videos to demonstrate the calculation methods we use in school for addition and subtraction in mathematics. I know that parents/carers sometimes ask for support in knowing the methods we use in school, as sometimes they are different to the methods they were taught as children. There is also a copy on the school website.


