BEAM is a new mental and emotional health service.

BEAM is run by The Children's Society.

BEAM is a new drop in for children and young people up to the age of 25.

BEAM is open every Monday 1pm until 5.30pm

- If you need some advice, a listening ear or just want to get some more information on how to feel better about yourself, come and see us.
- You will be met with a friendly face and someone to talk to if you want to about anything on your mind.
- You don't need an appointment or permission to come, just drop in.
- A variety of qualified staff will be on hand to offer advice and guidance on low-level emotional health and wellbeing needs.
- Staff include Mental Health Nurses, OTs and other Psychological Well-being practitioners and Youth Workers.
- There will also be a team of trained volunteers with special skillsets, to engage effectively with children and young people.
- The drop in is for children and young people aged 0-25.
- Parents are required to remain with young children whereas young people can drop in by themselves.
