Sporting Events took place across the school

Dear Parents, Carers and Governors,

I want to say a massive 'thank you' for all your support with school over the past year and a half! New systems were put in place, which you have adhered to and worked with us on whether it was face masks, one-way systems or bubble closures - I am extremely grateful!

In the news, it is suggesting that by 19th July many COVID restrictions will be able to be lifted. I am really hoping that by September we will not need to keep the children in class bubbles and many systems will be back to some normality! I know that the School Council have been working with Mrs Shephard about the changes they have liked and would like to keep and those that they want back!

September

I would like to try moving back to you being able to enter and leave from any of the gates rather than following the one-way system. Some of you may have liked the one-way system due to the flow of it and not many people going in all different directions. However, some of you may be walking past a gate to enter the other side of the school.

Please be mindful of each other e.g. when coming in and out of the same gate - particularly with pushchairs, you will need you to be patient. I think we might find it hard to start with as we have been used to having space around us. Hopefully, we will settle quickly back in to the old routine!

All gates will be opened at 8.30am. This is so that the nursery children can get to class. If you have a nursery child and other children, please drop off your nursery child, then wait by the door to the classroom with your other child. Reception - Year 6 children should arrive on school premises between 8.40am - 9am. We are continuing to enter school through their outside classroom doors, as we have felt this has been successful. All gates will be closed at 9am.

When collecting your child, the gates to the school will open at 3.05pm. You are welcome to come and wait on the playground around school near the door to the classroom your child will come out of. The classroom doors will open at 3.15pm. Children can be collected between 3.15pm - 3.30pm. Children walking home on their own in KS2 will be asked to leave through the exit on the KS2 playground only.

Staff will be around on the playgrounds to help you find the classrooms for the first few days.

All Nursery, Reception, KS1 & Year 3 children will need to be dropped off and collected by an adult with responsibility for their care. Current Y3,4,5 children who walk home on their own can continue to do so straight away from September. New Year 3 children will need to be dropped off and collected by an adult for the first week; if the parents then want them to walk home on their own, you will need to inform your class teacher.

Reception

We will be following the normal transition of mornings only to help the children settle into school for Reception. This will be from Monday 6th - Friday 10th September where they will only attend from 9-1pm - this will include their lunch.

From Monday 13th September the Reception children will attend school full time.

Nursery

Morning and Afternoon nursery will return from Monday 13th September.

Morning Nursery - Starts at 8.30am - you will come in through any gate to the school to drop off. You will collect at 11.30am from the KS1 playground nursery gate.

Afternoon Nursery - Starts at 12.30pm - you will come in through the KS1 playground nursery gate. You will collect at 3.30pm, coming in through any gate.

Transport

We would politely ask you to avoid using public transport where possible - instead walk or cycle! If it absolutely necessary for you to drive your child to school, please can we ask that you do not drive or park in Westbourne outside of the school gates. We want to ensure that parents and children can safely enter school! This has been so much better for the children at the front of the school. We really appreciate your support with this!



Parents in school

Unfortunately, to start with we are minimising the amount of people within the school building, parents & carers will not be allowed in until we are sure that no new procedures are needed later in the Autumn term. This means that all children will need to be dropped off and collected from their classroom door - this applies to reception and nursery as well. If your child becomes upset when you get to the door, please step aside from the pathway, and reassure your child until they are ready to enter the building.

Before and After School Provision

These sessions will be available through **application only** and will be in place to support people being able to go to work. Normal after school clubs will start back and a timetable will be released in the Autumn term.

Breakfast club is available from 7.45am-8.30am and will be serving breakfast. The price is £1.50 per session and for other siblings it will cost £1 each.



After school provision is from 3.30pm - 5.30pm. It will be based in the Rocket room which can be accessed from the KS2 playground. You will need to complete an application form to attend this session.

The cost is £5 per session.



To apply for either of these provisions, please ask for an application form from the office or complete the one attached to the email. All payments will be made through

ParentPay.

For either of these sessions, we ask that you *book in advance for each half term.*

You can email your application form back to school to apply for a place for breakfast club and/or after school childcare. Places will be limited and allocated on a first come, first serve basis.



Water bottles

We do ask that you supply your child with their own drinks bottle with either water or squash (no fizzy drinks). This means they can be taken home to be washed and refilled each day. We have noticed that some water bottles are quite difficult to open so please ensure your child brings a bottle that they can open by themselves.

Uniform

Children must attend in school uniform, including black shoes. This is the light blue polo shirt, navy cardigan or jumper, black/grey trousers, skirt or blue/white checked dress. The school logo uniform can be purchased on ParentPay. PE Kit - Plain white T-shirt with black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms. **Please order and collect before we break up.**

Alternatively, you can collect uniform on Friday 27th August (10.30am - 1pm) or Monday 6th September from the main office.



It is our policy that pupils do not wear jewellery to school. We have assessed the risk of injury to pupils and in order to reduce the risk we have agreed a policy whereby pupils may only wear small earrings, if their ears are pierced, and a watch (not a smart watch). These need to be removed for all PE activities.
