Last half term, children in Base 5 braved the rain and wind to participate in the RSPB Big Schools' Birdwatch 2026.




As part of our Science work on microhabitats, the children ventured into our school grounds to observe and record the types of birds spotted and their numbers.


Despite the challenging weather, the children showed great determination and thoroughly enjoyed the experience. Their observations revealed that the school grounds are home to larger birds such as pigeons, and magpies along with smaller birds such as sparrows and robins.



Inspired by their findings, the children made more small feeders to encourage more bird species to visit in the future.



The children enjoyed listening to stories about birds to help them learn how to identify birds by learning their features and names.



Each child who took part received an official RSPB Big Schools' Birdwatch Certificate to celebrate their efforts and contributions to this important conservation initiative.
